

ALCHEMY 2017 RULES AND TERMS

1. Alchemy has a Sound Policy which applies to all camps and participants running amplified sound, which is available for review at Connexus and the entry Gate. Failure to comply may result in loss of permission to run amplified sound, or removal from the Event.
2. Photography and video images may only be taken of participants and their property, including art installations, by first asking and obtaining permission from the individual or owner. Photographs and video images may not be used for commercial purposes or personal profit without the express written permission of the Flashpoint Artists Initiative, Inc. ("FAI") Board of Directors and the individuals in the photographs (or the owner of any intellectual or other property in the photographs). Photographs and video images of participants and their property taken without their permission must be deleted and destroyed upon the request of the individual or owner of the property. There are "no photography" wristbands available and you may not photograph individuals wearing such wristbands. Violation of this policy may result immediate ejection from the Event and other penalties allowed by applicable law.
3. **All participants must read and abide by the Survival Guide**, which is available on the Event website at <http://www.alchemyburn.com>, and also at the entry gate and Connexus, and is incorporated into these Rules and Terms by reference.
4. The Burn Perimeter has a "no tolerance policy" for breaking the safety perimeter. Breaking the safety perimeter for the Burn is grounds for **immediate ejection** from the Event.
5. In case of a medical issue where the Participant is required to leave the Event to obtain medical treatment, readmission to the Event will only be allowed if (1) the Participant obtains medical treatment, (2) the treating medical professional provides a written release that it is safe to return and (3) Flashpoint accepts the recommendation and at their discretion allows the Participant to return.
6. Participants may be permitted a limited time to load or unload vehicles at their camp. However, participants may also, in the sole discretion of FAI, be required to transport their materials to or from their campsites by other means, which may include shuttle service provided by FAI personnel or other volunteers and third parties, or by foot. You will need to check with the arrival gate at the time of arrival to confirm the current policy when you arrive. Failure to abide by this policy may result in unilateral removal of your vehicle by FAI personnel or individuals contracted by them to the official parking area, or other enforcement actions, without further notice to you, and neither FAI, nor any individual performing such action shall be liable to anyone for any damages associated with such removal or enforcement actions.
7. Only working service animals are allowed at Alchemy. No other animals may be brought or kept on the event premises. Therapy animals, emotional support animals, and personal pets which are not service animals are not permitted. Service animals are defined as dogs (or certain miniature horses) that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Service animals must remain under control, and may be asked to leave if the animal's handler does not take effective action to control it. If you require additional support/information to fully access the event and would like to provide emergency contact information for your service dog, or have any other concerns the Service Animal Task Lead will be available before and during the event.
8. Alchemy is an all-ages event. However, all children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. FAI reserves the right, but is not obligated, to contact local emergency services or law enforcement as needed in its sole discretion in order to protect the safety and well-being of any unaccompanied minor child found at the Event without further notice. Alchemy contains adult themes, some of which may not be appropriate for minor children – parents and guardians bear sole responsibility for the minor children they accompany and their experience at the Event.
9. All participants are required to abide by any and all federal, and state and local laws, including as pertain to firearms, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, and controlled substances. Violation of any of these laws may be grounds for immediate ejection from the Event without refund at the sole discretion of FAI, without refund.
10. All vehicles including trucks, trailers and RVs entering the Event are subject to search by FAI personnel for stowaways, animals, guns, or other prohibited items.
11. FAI reserves the right (but not the duty or obligation) to eject participants, without refund, who: (1) violate the Rules and Terms; (2) are determined in the sole discretion of FAI or its authorized personnel to pose a hazard or unreasonable risk of damage or harm to other attendees of the event, FAI personnel, or their property; or (3) engage in behavior which endangers the property and assets of FAI or its attendees (including causing a risk of increased cost for or difficulties in obtaining insurance), as determined in the sole discretion of FAI or its authorized personnel. Any such determination and ejection shall be binding and final.
